There are no pre-requisite courses for Anthropology minor program, but it is recommended that the student starts with ANTH 1102. After which, the student is required to take one of the three "Case Studies" Courses (ANTH 1105, 2001, OR 2002). The rest of the program is made up of twelve credit hours of any upper-level Anthropology courses. It is a very straight-forward degree program with a lot of flexibility in sequence and timing. It can theoretically be completed in one semester pending availability (although not recommended).
