# ECONOMICS MINOR

- ☐ Fall 1: ECON 2105 and ECON 2106 (C or higher for both)
- ☐ Spring 1: Upper Division ECON Elective
- ☐ Summer 1: Optional: Upper Division ECON Elective
- ☐ Fall 2: Upper Division ECON Elective
- ☐ Spring 2: Upper Division ECON Elective (if no summers)

- Students will need both ECON 2105 & 2106 (with a C or higher) as well as 45 completed credit hours and a 2.0 GPA before moving on to upper level courses. Two-three ECON electives are available each semester, so summers are optional. Experience in MATH 1413 (or a higher math) is not required, but is strongly recommended by the department.
- Students will likely need a Field of Study override to add upper level ECON. Also, certain ECON electives have CISM 2201 as a prerequisite. Any upper division classes in ECON that they have pre-reqs to take are required.
