Students with a minor in Psychology will need to take PSYC 1101 followed by 16 upper-level Psychology classes. If a student takes all 4-credit upper-level PSYC courses, they can finish this minor with a total of 1 intro class and 4 upper-level courses. However, if a student takes a 3-credit PSYC course at any point in their minor, they will therefore need an additional upper-level course to satisfy their requirements. It is therefore advisable for students to take all 4-credit PSYC 3xxx/4xxx courses (though if the subject material is important/of interest to students in a 3-credit PSYC course, they can take the one extra PSYC upper-level and have the overflow credit count as elective credit).
