Art History minor can be completed in 4 or 5 semesters. Students must take both ART 2201 and 2202 before they can take 32/42XX Art History courses. ART 3210 (Non-Western Art History) is repeatable up to 9 hours as long as the topics change. Students are encouraged to take 32/42XX Art History courses available online over the Summer where applicable as well.

It is recommended for Studio Art minors to also complete ART 1008 (prerequisites are ART 1006/1007) if there is elective space in their degree, as the prerequisite for all introductory 3/4XXX Studios are: 1006, 1007, 1008, and 1009. If the student is missing ART 1008, they will have to email faculty to request overrides into ALL upper level studio work to complete the minor. Studio Art minors should NOT take Graphic Design courses. Studio Art minors are also encouraged to take 3/4XXX Summer Studios upon completion of ART 1006, 1007, and 1009.
