Depending on which route will determine how many Film Studies Courses are required. Film Studies Courses: COMM 3356, HIST 4485 History in Film, PHIL 3160, FILM 3200, ENGL 4109, FORL 3111, FORL 4485, FREN 4210, GRMN 4220, GRMN 4240, GRMN 4240, GRMN 4250, SPAN 4200, PSYC 4085 Psychology and Film, THEA 3290, THEA 4485, and FILM 4081. Other courses at discretion of the Film Studies Coordinator within the English Department.IMPORTANT: Must take courses from at least 3 different disciplines. IMPORTANT: Mass Communication and Film and Video Production Majors can only take 1 COMM course in the Minor.
