## ENTREPRENEURSHIP & SMALL BUSINESS

- ☐ Fall 1: BUSA 2106
- ☐ Spring 1: MGNT 3600
- ☐ Fall 2: MGNT 3635 (fall only)
- ☐ Spring 2: MGNT 3603 (spring only)
- ☐ Fall 3: MGNT 3618

- To enroll in upper-level (3000/4000) business courses, a student must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 and must have completed at least 45 credit hours.
- Due to the RCUD policy, non-business Entrepreneurship & Small Business minors will need override codes into all MGNT classes & BUSA 2106.
- Student can override the MKTG 3803 prerequisite for MGNT 3618.
- BUSA 2106, MGNT 3600, and MGNT 3618 are offered every semester.

## HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

- ☐ Fall 1: BUSA 2106 (Prerequisite to MGNT 3600)
- ☐ Spring 1: MGNT 3600 (Prerequisite to MGNT 4620 & 4681)
- ☐ Summer 1: MGNT 4620\* and MGNT 4681 (summer only)
- ☐ Fall 2: MGNT 4621 (fall only)\*\*

\*MGNT 4620 is a concurrent prerequisite and can be taken before or with MGNT 4681  
\*\*If concurrent prerequisite MGNT 4620 is not taken in summer it can be taken in fall with MGNT 4621

- To enroll in upper-level (3000/4000) business courses, a student must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 and must have completed at least 45 credit hours.
- MGNT 4621 and MGNT 4681 are semester specific and can be rearranged to fit in the appropriate semester, if needed.

## MANAGEMENT (BUSINESS MAJORS)

- ☐ Spring 1: MGNT 3/4XXX (Student's Choice)
- ☐ Fall 2: MGNT 3/4XXX (Student's Choice)

- ☐ Fall 3: MGNT 3/4XXX (Student's Choice)

- To enroll in upper-level business courses, a student must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 and must have completed at least 15 credit hours. Business majors must complete the RCUD Policy before taking 3000/4000 level classes.
- Once MGNT 3600 is completed with a C or better, it may be possible for student to take remaining three courses during the same semester.
- Students cannot take MGNT 4660 Strategic Management for a business minor.

- ☐ Spring 2: MGNT 3/4XXX (Student's Choice)
- ☐ Fall 3: MGNT 3/4XXX (Student's Choice)

- To enroll in upper-level business courses, a student must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 and must have completed at least 45 credit hours.
- Once MGNT 3600 is completed with a C or better, it may be possible for student to take remaining three courses during the same semester.
- Students cannot take MGNT 4660 Strategic Management for a business minor.

## SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT

- ☐ Fall 1: MGNT 3600
- ☐ Spring 1: MGNT 3615 (Can be taken concurrently with MGNT 3600)
- ☐ Summer 1: MGNT 3640 (summer only)
- ☐ Fall 2: MGNT 4610 (fall only)
- ☐ Spring 2: MGNT 4615 (spring only)

- To enroll in upper-level (3000/4000) business courses, a student must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 and must have completed at least 45 credit hours.
- BUSA 2106 pre-req for MGNT 3600 can be overridden, as well as any Field of Study restrictions.
- MGNT 3600 and MGNT 3615 are prerequisites to the other three courses listed.
- MGNT 3600 and 3615 are offered every semester. All of the other courses are on rotation notated above. Note that one summer class is required for this minor.
