- CISM 3340 has been offered in Spring or Summer. Course is on rotation.
- CISM 3470 has been offered in Summer or Fall semesters. Course is on rotation.
- CISM 4310 has been offered in Fall or Spring semesters. Course is on rotation.
- Non-business students do not need to take CISM 2201, prerequisite to CISM 3330.
