Lecturer - Economics

Responsibilities: The primary teaching responsibilities are in the areas of Economics and business statistics, e.g., introductory microeconomics, introductory macroeconomics, consumer economics, introduction to business statistics, and business programming [using SAS, R, or Python]. Individuals will teach online, face-to-face, hybrid, and high-flex modes (simultaneously online and face-to-face) at the undergraduate and graduate levels. Professional responsibilities may include directing the Richards College Center for Economic Education and Financial Literacy, which requires engagement with the Georgia Council on Economic Education, local PreK-12 economics educators, local civic groups, chambers of commerce, and other groups interested in economic education and financial literacy. Additional expectations include professional development, scholarly research activity (which may include, but is not limited to refereed journal publications), service to the department, college, and UWG community. **Required Qualifications:** Earned master's degree (MS, MBA, MA, or equivalent with 18 graduate hours of economics/Analytics earned) in Economics, Analytics, or closely related field. **Knowledge, Skills, & Abilities:** (1) Earned master's in Economics, Analytics, or closely related field. (2) Commitment to excellence in teaching and student engagement. (3) Ability to teach face to face, hybrid, and online courses at the undergraduate level; (4) Ability to engage in professional development, and conduct professional/scholarly research; and (5) [Commitment to provide] service to the department, college, and UWG community.
